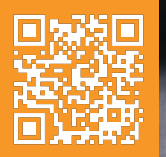

The Master's course in Clinical and Health Psychology at Universidade Lusófona - Centro Universitário Lisboa is aimed at students who have completed a 1st cycle degree in Psychology. The 2nd cycle of studies is characterised by theoretical and practical training aimed at acquiring knowledge and skills in the area of mental health and the psychological dimensions associated with physical health. In addition, students are expected to acquire research skills that enable them to act according to models based on empirical evidence.
