This Master's degree, taught entirely through distance learning (EAD), offers an interdisciplinary approach to Mediation, Conflict Management, and Citizenship to students of Education Sciences (such as teachers, educators, and animators) and Social and Behavioral Sciences (such as psychology, law, social work, political science, sociology, and philosophy) from Portuguese-speaking countries. Inspired by UNESCO's perspective on Global Citizenship, the course values mediation as a methodology that promotes coexistence, peace, and social justice, enhancing the (re)construction of bonds, empowerment, and inclusion in challenging social contexts, in line with the UN Sustainable Development Goals.
