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Presentation

The Postgraduate Course in Integrated Emergency Management: Safety & Security has been developed with the aim of equipping professionals involved in emergency management – specifically within civil protection agencies, the fire service, law enforcement agencies, local authorities and organisations responsible for essential services – to work in an integrated manner across preparedness, response, coordination and recovery in complex crises. With a total of 100 hours, comprising 86 hours of distance learning and 14 hours of classroom-based learning, the course combines a conceptual and methodological framework with a strong practical component. The training covers core topics such as the functioning of operational coordination centres, inter-institutional coordination, operational safety, information management, crisis communication and decision-making using decision-support tools, namely operational information systems, scenario analysis models, risk matrices, situational dashboards and structured decision-making methodologies in contexts of uncertainty, integrating the perspectives of safety (management of unintentional risks) and security
