

1. ABOUT US

Universidade Lusófona is the largest private university in Portugal. The entity that is legally responsible for managing and developing the university is COFAC - Cooperativa de Formação e Animação Cultural, a not-for-profit educational entity, located in Lisbon, Portugal.

The name of the university comes from the term "Lusophony" - the peoples and nations that share the Portuguese language and culture -, which is the central landmark of its institutional mission.

The University has two campus, in Lisbon and Porto, which are located at the heart of the two main Portuguese cities.

In its core institutional mission Universidade Lusófona advocates tolerance, inclusion, and equal opportunities as its central values, presently gathering a students' body of more than 16,980 students and 1.671 teaching staff, articulated in the 15 Faculties, Schools and Institutes.

7. HOW MANY ECTS SHOULD I COMPLETE IN MOBILITY?

Within Portuguese Higher Education System, one academic semester corresponds to 30 ECTs and one academic year to 60 ECTs. The mandatory number of ECTs to be achieved should be defined before the mobility, through the LA's (see topic above) taking consideration students' needs and expectations.

INSURANCE

EU CITIZENS

Students from EU countries should obtain the European Health Insurance Card in their country of origin before to traveling to Portugal. The European Health Insurance Card gives access to the Portuguese public health system sns.gov.pt.

NON- EU CITIZENS

Students who are not European Union citizens must obtain a valid private health insurance, (a copy of the insurance policy will be demanded in order to enroll at the University).
