She is the director of the PhD programme in Communication and Activisms, and researcher of CICANT – Centre for Research in Applied Communication, Culture, and New Technologies.

Her areas of specialization are communication sociology, sociology of the event and the theories of public space. Her research focuses on the media configuration of events, collective memory, media, reception and publics, networks and activisms, visibility and invisibility. She is the author of several books, namely, *Espectadores e Públicos Activos* (2015), *A configuração dos acontecimentos públicos. O caso República e as manifestações nos Açores em 1975* (2006), co-editor of *Ativismo em Rede e Plataformas Colaborativas* (2022) among others, author of book chapters and papers.
